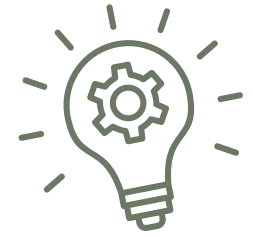


Vocational Rehabilitation and Pre-Employment Training Services



Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) and Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VRS) are available to students enrolled in school to get and keep employment. While Pre-ETS is for eligible students during high school, VRS can provide help to those who have exited school who need still need help with job exploration, placement or advancement.

Pre-ETS is for transition age students with disabilities.

VRS is for anyone with a barrier to employment regardless of age or disability.

✔ **Free Services-** Both Pre-ETS and VR services are available to qualified students at no cost to the participant.

✔ **Individualized Services-** From job skill development to career exploration to job placement, both Pre-ETS and VR offer unique and individualized employment related services.

✔ **Collaborative Effort-** Pre ETS and VR can work alongside school staff and families to support individuals in reaching their employment goals.

✔ **Getting Connected-** Students enrolled in a public school can contact their teacher or special education services to get connected to either Pre-ETS or Vocational Rehabilitation.
